In this kitchen, we replaced the cabinet panel on the refrigerator with a new, sleek stainless-steel panel which made a huge impact to the room as a whole.








And a More Classically Modern Look

Now here is a project that took almost a year from start to finish! One of our clients had a fireplace fire and we helped her with all three (yes THREE!) insurance companies, getting drawings and permits through the City, coordinating the remediation and the reconstruction. The homeowners were gone for nearly all the reconstruction, so we wanted them to see a picture-perfect result. If the before and after picture look so similar you question whether they are the same, please look at the design of the fireplace, the TV on the hearth, and the size of the hearth. *We are very proud of this project*!

The red 'danger' tape is because the fire inspectors would not allow anyone to touch that fireplace until they had determined the root cause of the fire. The modern and beautiful replacement fireplace is all electric — no more fires here!

Replacing tired and worn-out concrete driveways with pavers is a quick way to improve your curb appeal. These conversions take about a week, start to finish (once all materials are in hand) and there are many colors and patterns available.

Do you know the difference between tumbled pavers and non-tumbled? Tumbled are more rustic looking, they have irregular edges where non-tumbled pavers have very straight edges.

Here is another gorgeous tile backsplash we installed in a laundry room. It has a nice texture and looks amazing. It just goes to show, no matter how small the area, the right tile can make a big statement!

Speaking of small — don't let a small space intimidate you! Pinterest has tons of ideas for small spaces — here's one we did. The LG Thin Q washer/dryer unit is all one piece and offers full size drums. Dare I say 'oversized' drums? You can wash even king-sized comforters in these things. And for those that are getting a little up there in years, putting the unit on a pedestal helps save your back from bending so far down to reach all the way to the back of the washer to pull out heavy, wet clothes.

For those that are getting a little up there in years, putting the unit on a pedestal helps save your back from bending so far down. Here's another tiny project with a big transformation! The 'before' is a bit plain jane and very mid-90's.

Replacing the flooring, lighting, vanity, adding a weathered barnwood wainscoting and some pretty wallpaper gives this room both a masculine and a feminine vibe. And so much more inviting! (is that ok for a powder room?)

Wallpaper is making a big comeback! And not just as an accent wall, but entire rooms (and ceilings too!). In these photos, you will notice we reused the existing vanity (because it was tall enough) and converted it from a double sink to a single, then refaced the doors. The kitchen bar was dropped to be even with the rest of the countertop (but still room for barstools), and all new cabinets, sink, dishwasher, pendant lights and a whole new header to accommodate a widened entry door for the sitting room (not pictured).

Cabinet redesign, reface and replace. We often use existing items wherever we can. If you can dream it, we can make it a reality. It seems we do a lot of bathroom remodels. In this case there was the shower and tub, plus added cabinetry and all the floors. This was purely a case of upgrading from the original build of the condo and it turned out quite nicely!

The other side of the same bathroom — the tub, adjacent to the shower. Note how the faucet and handheld have been moved to the other side of the tub but the handles are within easy reach. The new rectangular tub, with its more evenly distributed jets, is a much needed upgrade from the old, original bathtub.


This is another project where I just loved how it turned out. We did the living room, the kitchen and dining room, plus some hallway cabinets and flooring throughout. For me, the most spectacular aspect is the fireplace. Wish we could take full credit for it - we installed the tile, yes, but the client picked it out and told us how to orient it. It is even nicer in person — very rich looking. We took out the divider wall and extended the new custom buffet all the way to the fireplace.

Opposite from the fireplace is this Chef's kitchen — it is spacious with plenty of countertop to go around. For this project some of the cabinetry was refaced and other is new. Some of the cabinets are white, the rest brown. The soffit was extended and more uniform LED lighting was installed. Bar top dropped for single height counter and a quartz waterfall edge creates movement in this modern space.



What a fun project! It was amazing to see the client's vision come to life through the eyes of our designer.


Reconstruction — After remediating water intrusion, it's time for reconstruction and it is important to blend repairs seamlessly into the surrounding areas. Small patch jobs or large, we can make you forget there was ever a mess in the first place. As one corrective action for a water intrusion event, we have added new gutters, rebuilt patios with the proper slope and added French drains. Finding the cause of the water intrusion is necessary if you hope to prevent it from happening again.



It's easy (but not very imaginary) to put a concrete deck around your pool but have you given any thought to pavers? Richer looking, provides extra drainage and has this added benefit: if you ever need to get under that deck it's infinitely easier to remove and replace some pavers than it is to saw cut and repour concrete (which will always look like a patch).

If you still want that concrete look, consider concrete pavers. Much more stylish and very modern. These large concrete slabs (er pavers!) come in various patterns and colors.

If you ever need to get under that deck it's infinitely easier to remove and replace some pavers than it is to saw cut and repour concrete. 

Oh, don't you just love the pristine look of freshly cleaned and sealed tile? Especially Saltillo tile. So pretty. We can apply any finish you like — matte, semi-gloss or high gloss.

Exterior tile is often neglected — either there is a lot of it and it will be costly to clean or, since the tile worsens in the weather over time, we often don't notice just how bad it really is.

Deferred maintenance for patio tile reduces its serviceable life and could result in cracked grout, cracked or broken tile or even cause the tile to lift.



Deferred maintenance for patio tile reduces its serviceable life and could result in cracked grout, cracked or broken tile or even cause the tile to lift. One of our earliest maintenance projects — as you can see the hard water deposits built up significantly after many years without attention. We had our doubts going in, but even we were astounded with the results!

We do recommend tile cleaning every 3-5 years depending on how hard the water is at your particular home. Could be as often as every 2 years, believe it or not. (if your water is hard enough to require tile cleaning every two years, be sure to have the water tested yearly — the pool may need to be drained and refilled if the calcium PPM exceeds safe limits).

BUT, we have a solution for pesky calcium too! A pool water treatment system that explodes the hardwater molecules; encouraging them to wash out rather than stick to the tile. And, there is no maintenance. You just bury it in the yard and forget about it! It doesn't 100% prevent scale from forming but it slows it down considerably.

We do recommend tile cleaning every 3-5 years depending on how hard the water is at your particular home. Never underestimate the breadth of our services — want to keep your home "model perfect" and keep it at its highest resale value? Avoid deferring maintenance — you may save some money in the short term, but untended problems exacerbate and may *not* be fully resolvable later.

Not all projects are big ones. In this case we needed to repair a wooden coffee table — why throw things out when they can easily be fixed? And I have to say, our furniture guy carries a magic wand, not a paint brush. We've seen him repair drawer fronts ripped off by overzealous renters, the thing in shards, and when he's done, it looks like nothing ever happened. He's so good in fact, he no longer takes on large projects due to scheduling constraints. He only does repairs like this one.




One of the best ways to refresh a room, both in appearance and smell, is to replace the carpet. Carpeting collects all sorts of dust, dust mites, sand, pet dander, sometimes mold, and microscopic 'yuck' that can build up a bad smell over time. Or, you might not even notice the smell, but traffic worn carpeting is still an eyesore. Here is a hint — no matter what carpet you buy, regardless of price, always opt for the highest quality pad you can afford. These days, the nicest ones are made from memory foam — it's like walking on a cloud. A good quality pad can make even inexpensive carpeting feel nice and good padding helps extend the useful life of the carpet.

And beware anyone using a lot of soap or hot water to clean it. Soap (believe it or not) attracts dirt so if excess soap is used and if not 100% rinsed out, spots will reappear. Proper cleaning of your carpet should leave it only damp — drying within an hour, or worst case two.



So many homes here in the desert have oversized, beautiful custom wood doors. And we live in a place where the heat can exceed 120 degrees F which can cause cracks or warpage. Worse, if a door is facing the wrong way, the sun will literally eat off the varnish and wear at the wood. Even UV protective varnish suffers.

This is another preventative maintenance item. If you keep after the doors and refresh them before they get too bad, the results can be breathtaking, and the doors will last much longer.

This especially applies to teak furniture or any other stained wood furniture you keep outside.

If a door is facing the wrong way, the sun will literally eat off the varnish and wear at the wood. We hope this portfolio of so many of our projects allows you to see what we see and that you can feel the passion we feel for helping our clients update, upgrade and remodel their properties.


